Objective 2: Clinical Decision Support	<p><i>In order for EPs to meet the objective they must satisfy both of the following measures:</i></p> <p><b>Measure 1:</b> Implement five clinical decision support interventions related to four or more clinical quality measures at a relevant point in patient care for the entire EHR reporting period. 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<p>Objective 3: Computerized Provider Order Entry</p>	<p><i>An EP, through a combination of meeting the thresholds and exclusions (or both), must satisfy all three measures for this objective.</i></p> <p><b>Measure 1:</b> More than 60 percent of medication orders created by the EP during the EHR reporting period are recorded using computerized provider order entry.</p> <p><b>Exclusion:</b> Any EP who writes fewer than 100 medication orders during the EHR reporting period.</p> <p><b>Measure 2:</b> More than 30 percent of laboratory orders created by the EP during the EHR reporting period are recorded using computerized provider order entry.</p> <p><b>Exclusion:</b> Any EP who writes fewer than 100 laboratory orders during the EHR reporting period.</p> <p><b>Measure 3:</b> More than 30 percent of radiology orders created by the EP during the EHR reporting period are recorded using computerized provider order entry.</p> <p><b>Exclusion:</b> Any EP who writes fewer than 100 radiology orders during the EHR reporting period.</p>	<p><b>Alternate Exclusion for Measure 2:</b> Providers scheduled to be in Stage 1 in 2016 may claim an exclusion for measure 2 (laboratory orders) of the Stage 2 CPOE objective for an EHR reporting period in 2016.</p> <p><b>Alternate Exclusion for Measure 3:</b> Providers scheduled to be in Stage 1 in 2016 may claim an exclusion for measure 3 (radiology orders) of the Stage 2 CPOE objective for an EHR reporting period in 2016.</p>	<p><b>Measure 1:</b> Exclusion <b>Measure 2:</b> Exclusion <b>Measure 3:</b> Exclusion</p>	<p>EP writes fewer than 100 prescriptions in the reporting period.</p>	<p>Physician <input type="checkbox"/> Statement for each measure</p>

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<p>Objective 5: Health Information Exchange</p>	<p><b>Measure:</b> The EP that transitions or refers their patient to another setting of care or provider of care must (1) use CEHRT to create a summary of care record, and (2) electronically transmit such summary to a receiving provider for more than 10 percent of transitions of care and referrals.</p> <p><b>Exclusion:</b> Any EP who transfers a patient to another setting or refers a patient to another provider less than 100 times during the EHR reporting period.</p>	<p>NONE</p>	<p>Exclusion</p>	<p>EP does not perform patient transfers.</p>	<p><input type="checkbox"/> Physician Statement</p>

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<p>Objective 8: Patient Electronic Access (VDT)</p>	<p>EPs must satisfy both measures in order to meet this objective:</p> <p><b>Measure 1:</b> More than 50 percent of all unique patients seen by the EP during the EHR reporting period are provided timely access to view online, download, and transmit to a third party their health information subject to the EP's discretion to withhold certain information.</p> <p><b>Exclusions:</b> Any EP who:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Neither orders nor creates any of the information listed for inclusion as part of the measures except for "Patient Name" and "Provider's name and office contact information."</li> </ul> <p><b>Measure 2:</b> For an EHR reporting period in <b>2016</b>, at least one patient seen by the EP during the EHR reporting period (or patient-authorized representative) views, downloads or transmits to a third party his or her health information during the EHR reporting period.</p> <p><b>Exclusions:</b> Any EP who:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Neither orders nor creates any of the information listed for inclusion as part of the measures except for "Patient Name" and "Provider's name and office contact information;" or</li> <li>Conducts 50 percent or more of his or her patient encounters in a county that does not have 50 percent or more of its housing units with 4Mbps broadband availability according to the latest information available from the FCC on the first day of the EHR reporting period.</li> </ul>	<p>NONE</p>	<p>Exclusion</p>	<p><b>Measure 1</b> EP neither orders nor creates any information listed for inclusion as part of the measures.</p> <p><b>Measure 2</b> EP neither orders nor creates any information listed for inclusion as part of the measures.</p>	<p><input type="checkbox"/> Physician Statement</p>
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<p>Objective 9: Secure Messaging</p>	<p><b>Measure:</b> For an EHR reporting period in <b>2016</b>, for at least 1 patient seen by the EP during the EHR reporting period, a secure message was sent using the electronic messaging function of CEHRT to the patient (or the patient-authorized representative), or in response to a secure message sent by the patient (or the patient-authorized representative) during the EHR reporting period.</p> <p><b>Exclusion:</b> Any EP who has no office visits during the EHR reporting period, or any EP who conducts 50 percent or more of his or her patient encounters in a county that does not have 50 percent or more of its housing units with 4Mbps broadband availability according to the latest information available from the FCC on the first day of the EHR reporting period.</p>	<p>NONE</p>	<p>Exclusion</p>	<p>EP does not perform office visits.</p>	<p><input type="checkbox"/> Physician Statement</p>
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<p>Objective 10: Public Health Reporting</p>	<p>An EP scheduled to be in Stage 2 in 2015 must meet 2 measures. All EPs must meet 2 measures in 2016 and 2017.</p> <p><b>Measure 1 – Immunization Registry Reporting:</b> The EP is in active engagement with a public health agency to submit immunization data.</p> <p><b>Exclusions:</b> Any EP meeting one or more of the following criteria may be excluded from the immunization registry reporting measure if the EP:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Does not administer any immunizations to any of the populations for which data is collected by its jurisdiction's immunization registry or immunization information system during the EHR reporting period; or</li> <li>• Operates in a jurisdiction for which no immunization registry or immunization information system is capable of accepting the specific standards required to meet the CEHRT definition at the start of the EHR reporting period; or</li> <li>• Operates in a jurisdiction where no immunization registry or immunization information system has declared readiness to receive immunization data from the EP at the start of the EHR reporting period.</li> </ul> <p><b>Measure 2 – Syndromic Surveillance Reporting:</b> The EP is in active engagement with a public health agency to submit syndromic surveillance data.</p> <p><b>Exclusions:</b> Any EP meeting one or more of the following criteria may be excluded from the syndromic surveillance reporting measure if the EP:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Is not in a category of providers from which ambulatory syndromic surveillance data is collected by their jurisdiction's syndromic surveillance system;</li> <li>• Operates in a jurisdiction for which no public health agency is capable of receiving electronic syndromic surveillance data from EPs in the specific standards required to meet the CEHRT definition at the start of the EHR reporting period; or</li> <li>• Operates in a jurisdiction where no public health agency has declared readiness to receive syndromic surveillance data from EPs at the start of the EHR reporting period.</li> </ul>	<p><b>Alternate Specification:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• In order to meet this objective an EP would need to meet two of the total number of measures available to them.</li> <li>• An exclusion for a measure does not count toward the total of two measures. If an EP excludes from a measure, they must meet or exclude from the remaining measures in order to meet the objective. If the EP qualifies for multiple exclusions and the remaining number of measures available to the EP is less than two, the EP can meet the objective by meeting the one remaining measure available to them. 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<p>Objective 10: Public Health Reporting (Continued)</p>	<p><b>Measure 3 – Specialized Registry Reporting:</b> The EP is in active engagement to submit data to a specialized registry.</p> <p><b>Exclusions:</b> Any EP meeting at least one of the following criteria may be excluded from the specialized registry reporting measure if the EP:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Does not diagnose or treat any disease or condition associated with, or collect relevant data that is collected by, a specialized registry in their jurisdiction during the EHR reporting period; or</li> <li>• Operates in a jurisdiction for which no specialized registry is capable of accepting electronic registry transactions in the specific standards required to meet the CEHRT definition at the start of the EHR reporting period; or</li> <li>• Operates in a jurisdiction where no specialized registry for which the EP is eligible has declared readiness to receive electronic registry transactions at the beginning of the EHR reporting period.</li> </ul>	<p><b>MEASURE 3:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• ALTERNATE EXCLUSION: EPs may claim an alternate exclusion for measure 3 (specialized registry reporting) for an EHR reporting period in 2016.</li> </ul>	<p>Yes (If EP has registered for a specialized registry and has reported data to that registry)</p>	<p><b>Measure Option 3:</b> Yes (If EP has registered for a specialized registry and has reported data to that registry) <b>Otherwise:</b> EP does not collect relevant data that is collected by a specialized registry</p>	<p><input type="checkbox"/> Documentation of data collected for specialized registry</p>
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# Notes

1. Any objective using the language "Seen by the EP" in the measure will only include patient encounters for patients with a study containing a procedure code (CPT code) with the "Seen by Physician" checkbox turned on.
2. Office Visit – Office visits include separate, billable encounters that result from evaluation and management services provided to the patient and include: (1) Concurrent care or transfer of care visits, (2) Consultant visits, or (3) Prolonged Physician Service without Direct (Face-To-Face) Patient Contact (tele-health). A consultant visit occurs when a provider is asked to render an expert opinion/service for a specific condition or problem by a referring provider.
